

There were several motions made at the April meeting that will be voted on at the May meeting that would change / alter the bylaws of the club and dues so please look over these motions and come in May to vote, the motions are listed below.

1. A motion was made by Jim Bouford and seconded by Ron Vaillancourt to raise the dues for members who live in a town further than ten miles from the city hall of Augusta to \$100.00 a year while the dues for members who live inside that distance would remain at \$50.00

2. A motion and seconded was made to do away with the discount to members as far as age is concerned. The discount would still apply to disabled and spouses.

3. A motion was made by Robert Sezak to change the wording in the bylaws under article III membership it would be changed to read—Any citizen of the United States of America, 18 years of age or older, may become a member of this organization on vote of the membership after submitting an application for membership, subscribing to the following pledge, on payment of the usual application fees and dues and attending the meeting of their application reading or make other arrangements as needed. All members must be sponsored by a club member or come to a meeting and introduce yourself to the membership.

4. A motion was also made by Robert Sezak to change the wording in the bylaws under article IV dues to read.

(A) The member's annual dues to the Club shall be payable on May 1st of each year.

(B) Dues shall be reduced or eliminated for members who meet the following conditions

1. (stays the same)

2. Members who are 62 years or older on May 1st.

3. Members who are handicapped

4. Members who are the spouse of a full fee dues paying member.

(D) There shall be an application fee for the first year of membership to the club.
