THANK YOU TO THE 100+ MEMBERS WHO CAME TO THE MEETING

A motion to raise the dues to a \$100.00 a year for members who live in towns outside a ten mile radius from the capital was retracted and never went to vote.

A motion to do away with the club discount for members over 62 was also defeated (do to the fact that it could not get a 2/3 majority vote)

A motion to do away with the club buttons was passed; this will save the club \$ 1,500.00 a year.

A motion to add a \$20.00 per year fee to members who use the indoor range was passed; this will add \$ 6,000 +/- a year to the clubs income. This will take effect next year

A motion to drop the money the club makes available to the Jr. Program from \$ 2,500 down to \$1,500 was defeated.

A committee will be established to look ahead for each upcoming year to try and determine the clubs financial needs for that year and how to meet them. We will have more on this after the committee is up and running.

There is a great need for volunteers to help maintain and do repairs of the club and grounds, help to set up, run and cleanup after matches (don't shoot and scoot help set up and tear down), we have projects that require electrical, carpentry, hvc, painting and labor. We could save over half the cost of repairs and projects with the help of club members. Keeping this club up to date, maintained and clean takes time, volunteers and money if we are going to keep dues at its current level we'll need your help. We have several things that need attention now, as soon as we put them in order we will post them on site and at the club house so if you can please volunteer some time and labor or give a donation to a project.
